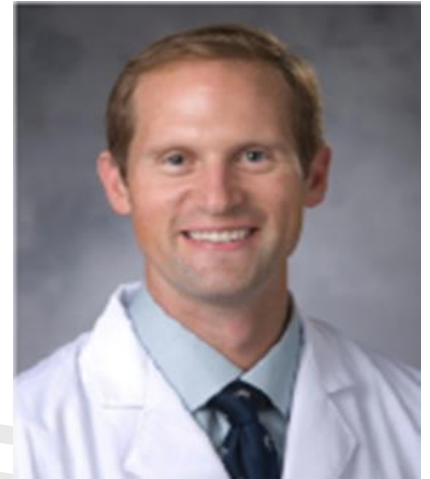


Ohio State Sports Medicine Grand Rounds

“The hip chose me and taught me about psychological distress in our patients”

Dr. Mather is a clinical associate and vice chairperson of practice innovation in the Department of Orthopaedic surgery at Duke University School of Medicine. Additionally, he is a faculty member at the Duke Clinical Research Institute. Dr. Mather is a health services researcher and decision scientist with a focus on economic analysis, health preference measurement, and personalized decision-making. His current work focuses on integrating patient preferences into routine care and shared decision-making. Additionally, he has a great interest health innovation, particularly in developing new care and payment models to foster different and practice approaches. His clinical practice focuses on hip arthroscopy including both FAI and extra-articular hip endoscopy. He also conducts translation research on biomarkers and hip instability.



Dr. Mather completed his medical school training and orthopaedic residency program at Duke University School of Medicine followed by an Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Fellowship at Rush University Medical Center.
