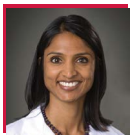
- Formulate the role of cataract surgery and glaucoma management.

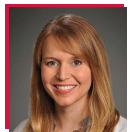

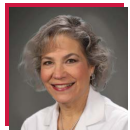
