The Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Sciences is offering an away rotation scholarship for historically underrepresented medical students for the upcoming academic year. The \$2000 scholarship will be used to help offset costs for travel, lodging and other student needs.

Students who would like to apply for a scholarship should be in their fourth year of medical school and interested in rotating at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. They should also have plans to apply for a residency position in Ophthalmology. Please note this is for students that were not awarded the College of Medicine Underrepresented in Medicine Visiting Student Program Scholarship.

Applicants should apply prior to the first day of their away rotation, and early submission is encouraged. Please provide a letter of interest (one page in length), an updated CV and one letter of recommendation. All applications will be reviewed by Ohio State College of Medicine faculty.
