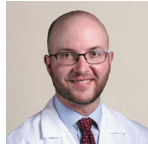

## GENERAL INFORMATION

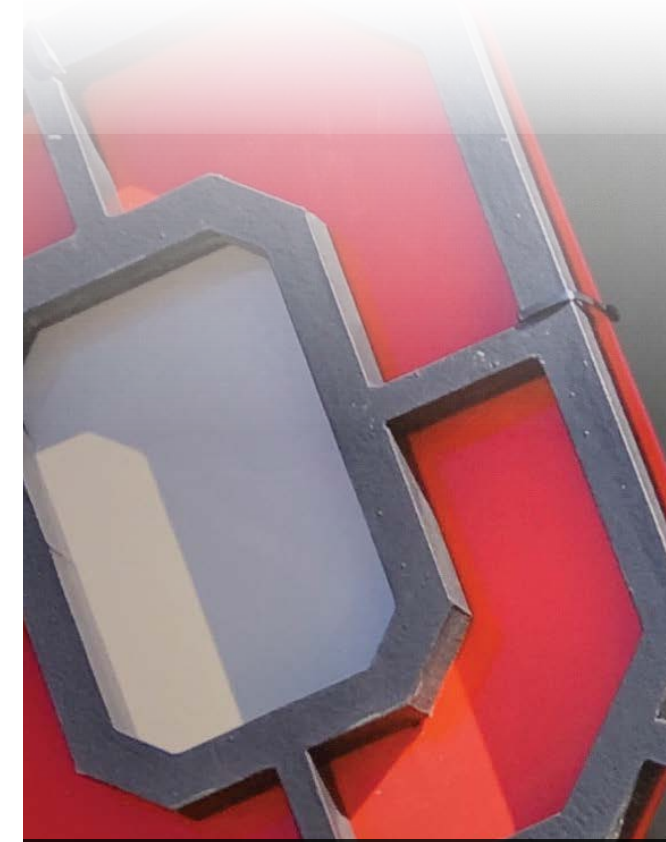

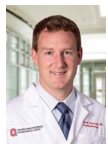
