The Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at The Ohio State University is committed to developing a diverse, equitable and inclusive environment. We recognize the value these principles have on an individual's personal growth as well as in our care of patients of various backgrounds and experiences. We welcome individuals of all gender, race, ethnicity, and sexual orientations to consider taking their next step in their career here with us at The Ohio State University.

We recognize that there are systemic forces that have deterred and continue to deter people of certain backgrounds from applying to Orthopaedic Surgery. To that end, we recognize the contributions of all individuals including, but not limited to, first generation students, those who have shown a commitment to furthering inclusion and belonging, and those who have overcome educational and economic obstacles.

Our scholarship provides financial assistance to fourth year medical students who are planning a career in orthopaedic surgery and would like to do a 4-week visiting sub-internship with us. Students planning a career in orthopaedic surgery, including those whose backgrounds and/or identities are underrepresented in orthopaedics, are encouraged to apply. Selected students will receive \$1,500 that can be used towards lodging and travel expenses during their time with us.

Applications from medical students who expect to do a visiting sub-internship during the calendar year of 2025 are now being accepted.

- Upcoming 4th year medical student or student who plans to enter residency in July 2026
- Undergraduate and Medical School Transcript
- Current Curriculum Vitae
- Maximum 200-word Personal statement
