Fellowship stipends and benefits for the current 20-21 academic year include:

- FY21 PGY-6 annual stipend is currently \$65,850. (The amount for the appointment year will not decrease from the current salary.)
- Comprehensive medical, dental, vision, life & disability [insurance and retirement](#) plan options.
- Paid liability insurance.
- Parking paid for by the Department.
- 15 days of vacation starting on Day 1.
- Accrued sick time (approximately 15 days/year).
- 5 interview days and 5 CME days permitted.
- \$1,500 professional expense allowance: primarily for attendance and/or presentation at a professional society meeting or review course (to be approved by your Fellowship Director and the Vice Chair of Education and Academic Affairs).
- Lab coats and scrubs. (Dry cleaning services also available.)
- On-call suite available (including beds, computer lab, kitchen, and workout area).
- Meal stipend for on-call duties.
- Personalized business cards.
- Access to the John A. Prior Health Sciences Library, Center for Knowledge Management, and Clinical Skills Education and Assessment Center.
- Access to the Department of Radiology Virtual Library.
- Access to STATdx.
- Paid memberships to The Ohio State Medical Association (OSMA), Columbus Medical Association (CMA), and the American Medical Association (AMA).
- Specialist available to help secure a full Ohio state medical license prior to OSUWMC training.
- Notary service available.

Our fellowships are structured to meet demands in the clinical, research, and academic missions. Each fellow is required to participate in a minimum of one research project of his/her choice with any of Department of Radiology faculty member in consultation with the Fellowship Director. The Department encourages development of educational skills by interacting with our residents and medical students and by engaging in interdepartmental conferences.
