**Required IR- related rotation*

- Residents have the option of completing the required Vascular Surgery rotations(s) at Ohio State or Fairfield Medical Center
- Residents have the option to schedule up to 1 IR-related elective during year 2 VIR rotations, in addition to the electives year 1. Elective choices include surgical oncology, medical oncology, hepatology, body interventional, pain management, or a hybrid procedural elective. Other electives to be approved by the Program Director.
- Resident is eligible for 15 paid vacation days per year.
- Resident can schedule 20 days of research time throughout the IR residency, which is not designated in a specific block.
- Resident is eligible for 15 paid vacation days throughout the year upon request.
