Sickle Cell in the Athletic Population

Sickle cell trait or Sickle Cell Disease, do you know the difference? Sickle Cell is an inherited red blood cell condition that can affect athletes at all levels. Sickle cell trait and Sickle cell disease is not necessarily a disqualification to play competitive sports. Athletes have experienced significant physical distress, collapse and death during intense exercise. Heat, dehydration, inadequate acclimatization, altitude and asthma can increase the risk for complications in athletes with sickle cell trait and disease.

Awareness, education and proper physical conditioning will allow athletes with sickle cell trait and disease to safely participate in athletics.

During this program, we will compare sickle cell trait and disease, provide considerations for nutrition and exercise for the athlete, and prevention and treatment protocol for the athletic trainer. After the program, participants will be able to:

- Participants will be able to distinguish between sickle cell trait & sickle cell disease.
- Participants will be able to list the common SCD complications.
- Participants will be able to develop a plan of care for athletes with sickle cell trait & sickle cell disease.
