

## Incoming Class of 2025 Estimated Cost of Attendance

**The Cost of Attendance (COA)** is an estimate of all cost associated with attending OSUCOM each financial aid year (summer – spring). It includes both direct and indirect cost.

**Direct Cost** – Expenses that will appear on your bill and must be paid to the university.

**Indirect Cost** – Reasonable estimates for other aid-eligible expenses, not directly paid to the university.

Your COA determines the maximum financial aid—scholarships, grants, and loans—you can receive and should serve as the foundation for your personal budget. Additional expenses, like OSU Insurance or childcare, may be included to increase your financial aid eligibility. If you enroll less than full-time any semester, contact our office to discuss potential impacts to your COA and financial aid.
