## THREE-YEAR PRIMARY CARE TRACK

The Ohio State University College of Medicine Primary Care Track (OSU-PCT) is intended for students with a committed passion in family medicine. The Three Year OSU-PCT MD program prepares students to be successful in a primary care career by providing strong faculty mentorship and advising for students, early and frequent clinical experience and a cultivated learning community. Our program is ideal for students who are eager to serve their community earlier and with the benefit of tuition scholarship, covering 50 percent on in-state tuition all three years. Students who successfully graduate from the Primary Care Track program will progress directly into the Ohio State Family and Community Medicine Residency Program, making this program a six-year medical school to residency pathway.

First-year students are assigned to a family medicine clinical site and continue there throughout the three years of medical school, which allows students to become an integral part of the family medicine health care team. The core curricular objectives of the three-year program are identical to the college's four-year track curriculum, Lead.Serve.Inspire, which introduces hands-on experience early in the program through longitudinal, practice-based, clinical service.

### Admissions Criteria

We are seeking students who will be the family physicians of the future. Students must demonstrate a commitment to social responsibility and a strong desire to enter into a career in family medicine.

Only students who meet the following criteria as demonstrated through their application and interviews will be considered for the program:

1. Demonstrated interest in family medicine and primary care through experiences, interests and understanding of the field.
2. Interpersonal and communication skills as well as Academic credentials predictive of success in an accelerated three-year program.

### Selection

- Apply for this program via the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) American Medical
- College Application Service (AMCAS)
- Selection will be competitive with up to four slots available
- Applicants to The Ohio State University College of Medicine will not be permitted to apply to both the traditional four-year MD program and the Primary Care Track; applicants may choose only one of these programs
